Tobacco-Free School

Notifications

Information about STREAM's tobacco-free policy and enforcement procedures shall be communicated clearly to employees, parents/guardians, students and the community.

Signs stating "Tobacco use is prohibited" shall be prominently displayed at all entrances to school property.

Enforcement/Discipline

Any employee or student who violates STREAM's tobacco-free school policy shall be asked to refrain from tobacco use and shall be subject to disciplinary action as appropriate.

Any other person who violates the STREAM's policy on tobacco-free school shall be informed of this policy and asked to refrain from tobacco use. If the person fails to comply with this request, the Co-Directors or designee may:

- 1. Direct the person to leave school property.
- 2. Request local law enforcement assistance in removing a person from school premises.
- 3. If the person repeatedly violates the tobacco-free school policy, prohibit him/her from entering the school property for a specified period of time.
